





Expand express toll lane (ETL) capacity.



Widen I-405 through the SR 522 interchange.

Improve connections for pedestrians and cyclists to transit and trails.





I-405 Brickyard – Project Update




I-405/SR 522 work zone locations



I-405 traffic shift near Northeast 160th Street


- Opened new work zones near Brickyard Park & Ride
- Completed staging/bus station relocation for Brickyard Station work
- Installing communications network infrastructure from Brickyard at Northeast 160th to the south end of the project.



Looking north at I-405 and Northeast 160th Street.

Northbound I-405 near SR 522 off-ramp

- Built soldier pile wall
- Building tieback wall





Looking northeast at soldier pile and tieback wall construction along northbound I-405.


Sammamish River Area/Woodinville Drive

Northbound I-405 to eastbound SR 522 bridge construction start:

- Pile installation, November 2024
- Foundations started south side, November 2024

Foundations start north side, March

2025

Temporary trail detour

Short reroute around the active work zone underneath the I-405/SR 522 interchange

Brief closures of the trail no longer than 15 minutes and not to exceed 45 minutes in a

day.

Par Creek fish passage **SR 522**

- Completed first segment of fish passage
- Shifted westbound SR 522 to northbound I-405 ramp traffic

Juanita Creek

Clear and grub west side of I-405 to prep site for construction – March

Brickyard Station Utility and foundation work – April




Looking northwest at the Brickyard Park & Ride on the westside of I-405.

Upcoming work

Westbound SR 522 to Northbound I-405 new on-ramp

Second phase of Par Creek work, final ramp alignment in place -April

SR 522 both directions lane shifts Lanes shift northward - April



Future alignment for SR 522 general purpose lanes and westbound SR 522 ramp to northbound I-405.



Upcoming work

I-405 lane shifts near SR 527 - April

Both northbound and southbound lanes shift to create space for future roadway configuration

Northbound I-405 to SR 527 ramp/North Fork Perry Fish Passage - April

- Access, egress to construct wall
- Clear and grub
- Build pond
